FALL CAMPING INFORMATION 2009

CAMPGROUND CLOSES OCTOBER 31

Gate - After Labor Day, there will be a 24-hour gate attendant. There is no need for special gate keys.

Fall Entrance Fee - Cost is \$5 per day per site when you are at the campground or plugged into the power box. For example, if you arrive on Friday and leave on Sunday, the charge will be \$15. The \$5 is a daily fee and is not based on 24 hours.

Electricity - Don't forget to unplug. You will be charged \$5 a day even if you are not here. Remove the cord completely from the power box; simply turning off the breakers is not good enough. After unplugging, protect your cords by wrapping them in a plastic bag or by storing them within your camping unit. This will prevent the cord from rusting. Rusty cords must be replaced.

Garbage - Garbage will be picked up from your lot on Mondays and Fridays only. Your garbage must be bagged and placed in a trash can. All occupied sites must have a covered trash can.

Water and Sewer Pumps - Sewer pumps will be done weekly. Water will be turned off to camping sites on October 18 at 5pm.

Bathrooms - 2nd street bath house will be open until October 31; Pool bath house until October 18; Oak Street and Tomahawk until September 8. Please keep them clean or we will have to close them earlier.

Winterizing Your Campers - Please remember to unhook and pick up any cords, hoses or other loose articles that could blow in storms or get caught in the mowers in the Spring. Uncontained woodpiles are not allowed.

Campground Closes October 31 - The lock on the gate will be changed on October 31 at 4pm. Starting in November, the gate will be open Sundays only from noon until 3pm. This is for your convenience so you can check on your camper. Only main roads will be snow plowed. We will **not** be open Thanksgiving Sunday (November 29) and all Sundays in December. We will resume on Sunday, January 3, 2010.

Mail - Mail will be delivered to your site if you have a mailbox. If you don't, check at the gate. Mail received at the campground after October 31 will be returned to sender. Be sure the office has your correct home address and phone number to mail your 2010 contract.

Campground Office - The office will be open daily 10 am - 4pm until October 31. The office will re-open March 1, 2010 with regular business hours.

Boats - Your boat may be stored on *your* lot only for the winter. They cannot be stored on empty and vacant lots or on GWA parking lots. Boats left anywhere else in the campground after October 31 will be removed and the owner will be charged a minimum \$100 removal fee. Boat storage is only for boats used on Goose Lake. Automobile, speedboat and storage trailers are **not** permitted. Boats must be back in the water the weekend before the Memorial Weekend, 2010. There is no winter storage by the golf course. If you are currently storing something in by the golf course storage area, it must be removed.

Curfew - The curfew is enforced until October 31. Quiet time is 11pm and golf cart curfew is midnight. All children, including teens, must be on their lot at dark when the streetlights come on. No golf cart caravanning unless approved by GWA management.

Thanks for your cooperation and see you in the Spring. For your convenience, monthly installment payments can be made toward your lot throughout the Winter months. Keep in mind the full payment due date and campground opening date for seasonal campers is April 1, 2010. Late charges will be added May 1, 2010.
