

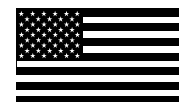

Your car pass must be adhered to your windshield. Do not use Velcro and tape to keep it in place. Or you can see office about getting a photo ID pass. The cost is \$5.

AGE RESTRICTIONS

At GWA, you must be 21 to drink and 18 to smoke. And please remember, in order to

drive any vehicle or golf cart while in the park, you must be 25 years old. If you have extenuating circumstances, see the office. All of the age restrictions also apply to your guests. Please inform your guests of these rules because you are responsible for their actions.
